## Clash of the Eastern & Western Armies! The Battles of Sekigahara & Gifu Castle

In 1600, Sekigahara, in Mino, became the stage for the fateful Battle of Sekigahara. Although this battle took place over the course of just one day, it was to be the largest determinant of the direction of Japanese history

going forward. This exhibit will introduce the role Mino played, and the details of the penultimate Battle of Gifu Castle, through artifacts and resources related to Oda Hidenobu and Todo Takatora.
