#### **Announcement** New Evacuation Preparation Information Categories

The categories of evacuation preparation information, which your municipality will issue in the event of disasters such as heavy rainstorms or typhoons, changed in December of last year.

Pay attention to the evacuation information from your municipality, and take care to evacuate in a timely fashion when necessary.

[Evacuation Preparation/Elderly etc. Evacuation]

The elderly, people with disabilities, and other individuals who will need time to evacuate should begin evacuating. Others should prepare for evacuation.

[Evacuation Recommendation]

Everyone should swiftly evacuate to an evacuation center.

[Evacuation Order (Emergency)]

If you are still not evacuated, then evacuate immediately. If going outside would put your life in danger, take shelter in the safest place within your home.
