Enjoy the Summer by Protecting yourself from Heatstroke!

There is a greater risk of heatstroke in the summer months.

This year, masks being worn to prevent the spread of COVID-19 pose a particular risk, as they trap body heat.

Please take precautions to protect yourself from heatstroke as you enjoy the summer months.

How to protect yourself from heatstroke

- Measure the room temperature frequently.
 Utilize air conditioning and fans well, aiming to maintain a room temperature of 28°C.
- Hydrate frequently, even if you don't feel thirsty.
- •Wear lightweight clothing and take measures to protect yourself from the sun when going outdoors.
- ●Don't overexert yourself and take frequent breaks.
- ●Eat meals that are nutritionally balanced and build up your physical strength.

How to Enjoy Rivers Safely

Recent years have seen a growing number of drowning accidents caused by sudden rises in water levels. Please exercise caution when playing by rivers, paying attention to weather and river conditions. Information about rainfall and water levels is available on the Prefecture's "Disaster Prevention Information for Rivers" website (「川の防災情報」). You can receive information about heavy rain and flooding to your phone automatically by registering for the "Gifu Rivers and Roads Alarm Mail" (「ぎふ川と道のアラームメール」).

Please Properly Maintain Trees and Shrubs which Protrude into the Road

If trees or shrubs protruding from private property are found to be the cause of an accident, the property owner may be held responsible for the accident. Please take care to properly maintain trees and shrubs. For prefectural roads which are emergency transportation routes or routes to communities predicted to become isolated following a natural disaster, subsidies are available to cover the cost of tree and shrub maintenance, so please utilize these.

Regarding *Anma* and *Shiatsu* Massage Treatments

There are two categories of massage treatments in Japan: treatments for which a national license is required such as *anma* massages, *shiatsu*, acupuncture or moxibustion, and chiropractic treatments for which such a license is not required. A list of treatment facilities which are registered as having licensed practitioners can be found on the Gifu Prefectural Government website.
