The Five Safety Rules

1

Don't be alone

- Avoid places that have few people and are out of view.
- Be cautious of your surroundings if you find yourself alone.



2

Don't follow

- Don't follow anyone who offers you candy.
- Don't get in a stranger's car.



3

Be loud

- Shout out if you feel you are being taken by someone or are in some kind of danger.
- Use a security alarm if you feel you have lost your voice.



4

Keep away

- If a stranger starts talking to you, keep a safe distance from them (more than an arm's length so that they cannot reach you).
- Run away immediately when you feel you are in danger.



5

Tell someone

- Tell your family where you're going, who you're going with and what time you will be home.
- Tell your family about your day.
- Tell an adult if a stranger talks to you.
