## Landslide Warning Grid Information

What are landslide warning grids?

Landslide warning grids are a type of information issued by JMA alongside information concerning landslide warnings and heavy rain warnings/advisories. Areas for which a landslide warning have been issued are broken up into 5x5km grids, with different colours representing different levels of risk. There are 5 risk levels in total. To allow time for evacuation from dangerous areas, the grid risk levels are calculated using predictions for the estimated soil water levels 2 hours after the announcement is issued.

Landslide warning grids can be used to get a more detailed sense of where within a village, town or city the risk levels for a landslide are at their highest when a landslide or heavy rain warning has been announced. People living in high risk areas should evacuate to safer areas outside of the warning zones as soon as possible.
