The beauty of the blue underglaze, and the *iki* aesthetic ideal of Edo townspeople, are transmitted to the present across the surface of these plates. You can examine their splendid charm in this hall display of 140 blue underglaze plates.

Kisshomon are designs of plants, animals, etc. believed to bring good luck.

Licenses are necessary in order to conduct medical treatments like massages, *anma* massages, *shiatsu*, acupuncture, moxibustion, or Judo therapy (bone-setting therapy) as a business. Anyone who conducts any of these acts for business without the appropriate license is liable to legal sanctions. When looking to receive massages, *anma* massages, *shiatsu*, acupuncture, moxibustion, or Judo therapy, please be aware of these laws, and get treatment from a licensed practitioner. A list of licensed facilities which provide these services is publically available on the Gifu Prefectural Government website.

In order to protect Gifu Prefecture's plentiful forests and clear rivers, the "Land of Clear Water Gifu: Forests & Environment Tax" has been in effect in the prefecture since 2012. Because an appropriate amount of time and continuous effort is necessary to preserve and revive the natural environment, we will be continuing our efforts, and extending the Forests & Environment Tax an additional five years, until the end of 2021. We request the understanding and cooperation of individuals with an address and businesses with a location in Gifu Prefecture.
