I. What is "監察故談"

Written by NAKAGAWA Tadateru (中川忠英 : 1753-1830)

Manual of *Metsuke* (目付)

Metsuke

- Bureaucrat of the shogunate
- 10-seat
- Responsibility is to inspect bannermen (旗本) and maintain Edo Castle
- Improvement of the status after early 19th century

II. Each characteristic of the "監察故談"

Japan

1. Historiographical Institute The University of Tokyo

It bears "Tokyo Imperial University Library, May 22 1903".

It is labeled "Donation of PhD in Science, JIMBO Kitora (神保小虎)".

神保小虎 (1867-1924)

- Geologist and Mineralogist
- Grandson of JIMBO Nagataka (神保長貴) served as *metsuke* from 1864 to 1865

2. Gifu Prefecture Archives (岐阜県歴史資料館)

TOKUYAMA Hideoki (徳山秀起) served as *metsuke* from 1834 to 1839 transcribed in 1836.

USA

Yale University

NANKO Makoto (南闡信) transcribed in 1860.

This was bound with "諸侯方官位席分警明" (Shokokata kanisekibun betumei) .

III. Spread of "監察故談" in Edo period
